


MFSA: The COVID-19 EPIDEMIC – SOURCES OF INFORMATION 20 March 2020

The COVID-19 EPIDEMIC - SOURCES OF INFORMATION

The MFSA is aware that there are many sources available regarding the COVID-19 Virus. Not all sources are credible. We suggest that you consider the following sources for updated information:

The Department of Health has launched a website specifically on the Corona virus. Simply insert https://sacoronavirus.co.za/ into the web browser and enter.

The Government has also set up an automated WhatsApp group to provide credible and factual details around COVID-19 (Corona). Simply add the number 060 012 3456 to your WhatsApp, type "HI" in the message block and send. There will be an automated response and you can regularly get an update on this format.
